BRSD Board approves 2019-2020 budget

On June 20, the BRSD Board of Trustees approved a budget for the 2019-2020 school year. The budget must be submitted to Alberta Education by the end of June.

No specific financial information has been made available to support school divisions in their planning for next year, so the budget is based on the assumption that base funding will be similar to the current year, with the elimination of such things as the Classroom Improvement Fund (CIF) grant and the Nutrition grant. BRSD will also be experiencing a decline in student numbers, so is preparing for a decline in funding. There are staffing changes being made in many areas, such as Administration, Facilities, Technology and division-wide services, in order to offset the reduction.

In conjunction with passing the budget, several other motions were approved, including setting next year's fees for everything from Pre-K children to Adult Students, Transportation, expense reimbursements and more.

Attendance boundaries made more flexible

The Board also passed a motion to make attendance boundaries for three elementary schools in Camrose, which have been closed for several years, more flexible next school year. The intent is still for families to send their child to their neighbourhood school, but to also provide additional opportunities for parents who feel their children would be better served at a different location.


International travel trips approved

Education Act changes could impact ward review

The Board of Trustees agreed to table discussion of the ward review that's been underway in Battle River this spring, as there is the potential that changes brought about by the approval of a new Education Act could impact decisions about next steps. No further work will be done on the ward review process until the Education Act is brought in next fall. Trustees and senior staff will be participating in a variety of webinars with Alberta Education staff over the summer, to learn more about upcoming changes.
