EQUIPMENT EVERGREENING GRANT

This grant, also provided by Alberta Education, is directed to C.T.S. programming in Construction and Home Economics to upgrade tools, equipment and facilities. Bashaw, C.H.S.P., Daysland, Forestburg, New Norway, Ryley, Tofield and Viking Schools will share the \$174,171 per year for a confirmed two years.
